### **Clinical Case Conference**

**Facilitator:** Lynn Superstein-Raber, Ph.D., R.Psych.

**Title:** Intersubjective Clinical Case Discussion Group

**Description:** Participants will learn to focus on the nuances that make up the intersubjective field of the therapy. Each session will be a two hour block where two people will present, each for fifty minutes. The presentations will be made up of the verbatim communication between the patient and the therapist with emphasis being placed on the transference-countertransference material. The presentation will be followed by a discussion of each case. We will decide, at the first meeting of the group, if we will follow a continuous case format of three sessions to each participant or will change off each week.
