Process and dilemma in psychoanalysis: Reflections on recent developments in technique

Psychoanalytic psychotherapy is learned as a *method*, but it also consists of therapeutic *processes* that the method is intended to foster and handle, such as transference, regression, play, working through, and mourning. Ideally, the techniques learned will be well adapted to the processes we wish to initiate. Yet it is in the very nature of a 'process' to exceed our attempts to control, predict, or codify its unfolding properties. This inherent tension between process and precept leads inevitably to technical dilemmas and a great deal of uncertainty in our work, about which we are naturally *ambivalent* (as we are with respect to reality in general). With the aid of clinical examples, this seminar will explore the problem of processes in analysis, suggesting how to welcome and work with the specific difficulties they generate.

Charles Levin is a bilingual training and supervising analyst at the Canadian Psychoanalytic Society, Quebec English branch in Montreal where he is in private practice. He has taught at McGill University in the Communications and Art History Departments where he has supervised theses in the graduate faculty. Dr. Levin is Associate Editor of the Canadian Journal of Psychoanalysis.
