Dynamic Group Psychotherapy Elie Debbane

Different theoretical models illuminate different aspects of group functioning. They share the fact that each of them start from the particular perspective they hold on individuals and individual development, and the importance they attribute to the characteristics of the group as a group.

This presentation is informed by a psychoanalytic "object relation" perspective on individuals and the characteristics that emerge out of their gathering as a group. It is suggested that the group situation will reveal aspects of the individual that are less apparent in the classical "individual" situation. In the analytic group certain defense mechanisms come to the fore while others remain in the background. The group also represents a public forum. It highlights the divide between public and private. Participation in the group takes the characteristics of Publicaction. Consequently certain issues become more difficult to explore in a group context. Finally a group therapy session will be presented to illustrate this model.

Elie Debbane is a training and supervising analyst with the Vancouver Institute of Psychoanalysis (VIP) and the Northwestern Psychoanalytic Society (NPS). Dr. Debbane is in private practice in Vancouver.
